

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From the Ten Square Pack, cut:

sixty-six 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles*

*Use the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific prints and note the direction of the cuts for some that are cut vertically and others that appear horizontally in the quilt

From the Fabric A yardage, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" side outer borders

two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From Fabric B, cut:

twenty-eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips

Sew together the remaining thirteen strips, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 61-1/2" side inner borders

seven 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" row sashing strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Block 1



Step 1: Gather:

five print rectangles* five block sashing strips

*Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific prints to use

Sew together, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Press the seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make two Block 1 units.

five print rectangles* five block sashing strips

*Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific prints to use

Sew together, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Press the seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make two Block 2 units.












Step 6: Gather:

Sew together in sections, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Press the seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make two Block 6 units



Step 7: Arrange the blocks into six rows, as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams toward the block sashing strips.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center, sewing a row sashing strip between each row. Press the seams toward the sashing.

Step 10: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center.

Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward

the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
