Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From each of Fabrics $A$ and $E$, cut:
two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: seven 6-1/2" squares three $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " rectangles one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangle one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut: one $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 40$ " rectangle

From each of Fabrics $B$ and $D$, cut: three 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 6-1/2" squares two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## From Fabric C, cut:

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 6-1/2" squares
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle two 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: six $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From each of Fabrics F and J, cut: three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: three $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangles twenty $2-1 / 2$ " squares

From each of Fabrics $G$ and $I$, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one 2-1/2" $\times 40^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle forty-six 2-1/2" squares

## From Fabric H, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one 2-1/2" x 40" rectangle two 2-1/2" $\times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles four 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangle sixty-eight 2-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips.

Step 1: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle between two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into four 2-1/2" E/F/E segments.

Step 2: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric E rectangle between two $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 5$ " Fabric F rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into two 2-1/2" F/E/F segments.
Step 3: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " Fabric D rectangle together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into four 2-1/2" E/F/D segments.
Step 4: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " Fabric D rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ G rectangle together in that order. Press.

Cut the strip set into four 2-1/2" F/D/G segments.


Step 5: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 40$ " Fabric $D$ rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ " Fabric $G$ rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 40$ " Fabric E rectangle together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into sixteen 2-1/2" D/G/E segments.
Step 6: Sew one 2-1/2" x $15^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangle between two 2-1/2" x $15^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into six 2-1/2" G/E/G segments.
Step 7: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " Fabric H rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into eight 2-1/2"D/H/C segments.
Step 8: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " Fabric C rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into eight 2-1/2" H/C/G segments.
Step 9: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{C} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{D}$ segments.

Step 10: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 40$ " Fabric H rectangle between two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ " Fabric C rectangles. Press.

Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle between two 2-1/2" x 5" Fabric C rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip sets into eighteen 2-1/2" C/H/C segments.


Step 11: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle between two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into six 2-1/2" H/C/H segments.


Step 12: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I rectangle, and one 2-1/2" x 20 " Fabric C rectangles together in that order. Press.

Cut the strip set into eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{B} / \mathrm{I} / \mathrm{C}$ segments.
Step 13: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " Fabric H rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into eight 2-1/2" I/C/H segments.
Step 14: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle, and one 2-1/2" x 20 " Fabric B rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into eight 2-1/2" C/H/B segments.
Step 15: Sew one 2-1/2" $\times 40$ " Fabric B rectangle, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ " Fabric rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into sixteen 2-1/2" B/I/A segments.
Step 16: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle between two 2-1/2" x 15" Fabric I rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into six 2-1/2" I/A/I segments.


Step 17: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I rectangle, one $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 10$ " Fabric B rectangle, and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J rectangle together in that order. Press.


Cut the strip set into four 2-1/2" I/B/J segments.


Cut the strip set into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{B} / \mathrm{J} / \mathrm{A}$ segments.

Step 19: Sew one 2-1/2" x 10 " Fabric J rectangle between two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " Fabric A rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A} / \mathrm{J} / \mathrm{A}$ segments.


Step 20: Sew one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle between two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric J rectangles. Press.

Cut the strip set into two 2-1/2" J/A/J segments.

## Assemble the Nine-Patch Blocks

Step 21: Sew one F/E/F segment between two E/F/E segments. Press. Make two blocks.

Step 22: Sew one E/F/D segment, one F/D/G segment, and one D/G/E segment together in that order. Press. Make four blocks.

Step 23: Sew one G/E/G segment between two D/G/E segments. Notice how one outer segment is rotated $180^{\circ}$. Press. Make six blocks.

Step 24: Sew one D/H/C segment, one H/C/G segment, and one C/G/D segment together in that order. Press. Make eight blocks.

Step 25: Sew one H/C/H segment between two C/H/C segments. Press. Make nine blocks.

Step 26: Sew one $B / I / C$ segment, one $I / C / H$ segment, and one $C / H / B$ segment together in that order. Press. Make eight blocks.

Step 27: Sew one I/A/I segment between two A/I/B segments. Notice how one outer segment is rotated $180^{\circ}$. Press. Make six blocks.

Step 28: Sew one $A / I / B$ segment, one $I / B / J$ segment, and one $B / J / A$ segment together in that order. Press. Make four blocks.

Step 29: Sew on J/A/J segment between two A/J/A segments. Press. Make two blocks.

Step 30: Place one 2-1/2" Fabric J square on each corner of a 6-1/2" Fabric A square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on each of the smaller squares, then sew on the marked lines. Trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams, then press.

Step 31: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric A square, two 2-1/2" Fabric I squares, and two 2-1/2" Fabric J squares. Make six blocks.


Step 32: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric B square, two 2-1/2" Fabric I squares, and two 2-1/2" Fabric J squares. Make two blocks.

Step 33: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric B square, one 2-1/2" Fabric H square, and three 2-1/2" Fabric I squares. Make seven blocks.

Step 34: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric B square,three 2-1/2" Fabric H squares, and one 2-1/2" Fabric I square. Make five blocks.

Step 35: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric C square, one 2-1/2" Fabric G square, and three 2-1/2" Fabric H squares. Make four blocks.

Step 36: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric C square, three 2-1/2" Fabric H squares, and one 2-1/2" Fabric I square. Make four blocks.

Step 37: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric D square, two 2-1/2" Fabric F squares, and two 2-1/2" Fabric G squares. Make two blocks.

Step 38: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric D square, three 2-1/2" Fabric G squares, and one 2-1/2" Fabric H square. Make seven blocks.


Step 39: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric D square, one 2-1/2" Fabric G square, and three 2-1/2" Fabric H squares. Make five blocks.


Step 40: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric E square and four 2-1/2" Fabric F squares.


Step 41: Repeat Step 30 using one 6-1/2" Fabric E square, two 2-1/2" Fabric F squares, and two 2-1/2" Fabric G squares. Make six blocks.


Step 42: Arrange the blocks into eleven rows of nine blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 43: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the evennumbered rows.

Step 44: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 45: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 46: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
