Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

five 10-1/2" squares centered on the animal motifs

From each of Fabrics B and C, cut:

one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 10-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

eleven 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighteen 2" x 13-1/2" rectangles
eighteen 2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
six 3-1/2" x 13-1/2" vertical sashing strips
Sew the three remaining strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:
two 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" horizontal sashing strips
five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:
two 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
two 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric F, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:
two 4-1/2" x 57-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
two 4-1/2" x 49-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

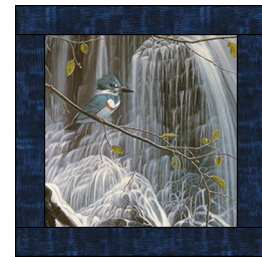
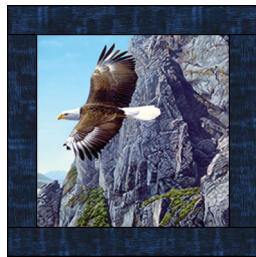
Step 1: Sew a 10-1/2" Fabric A square between two 2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D rectangles. Press.



Step 2: Sew a 2" x 13-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of the unit. Press to complete the block.



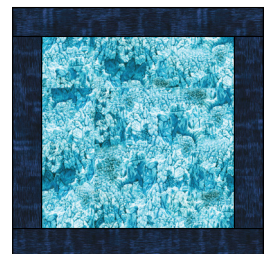
Step 3: Repeat Steps 1-2 to make four additional Fabric A blocks.



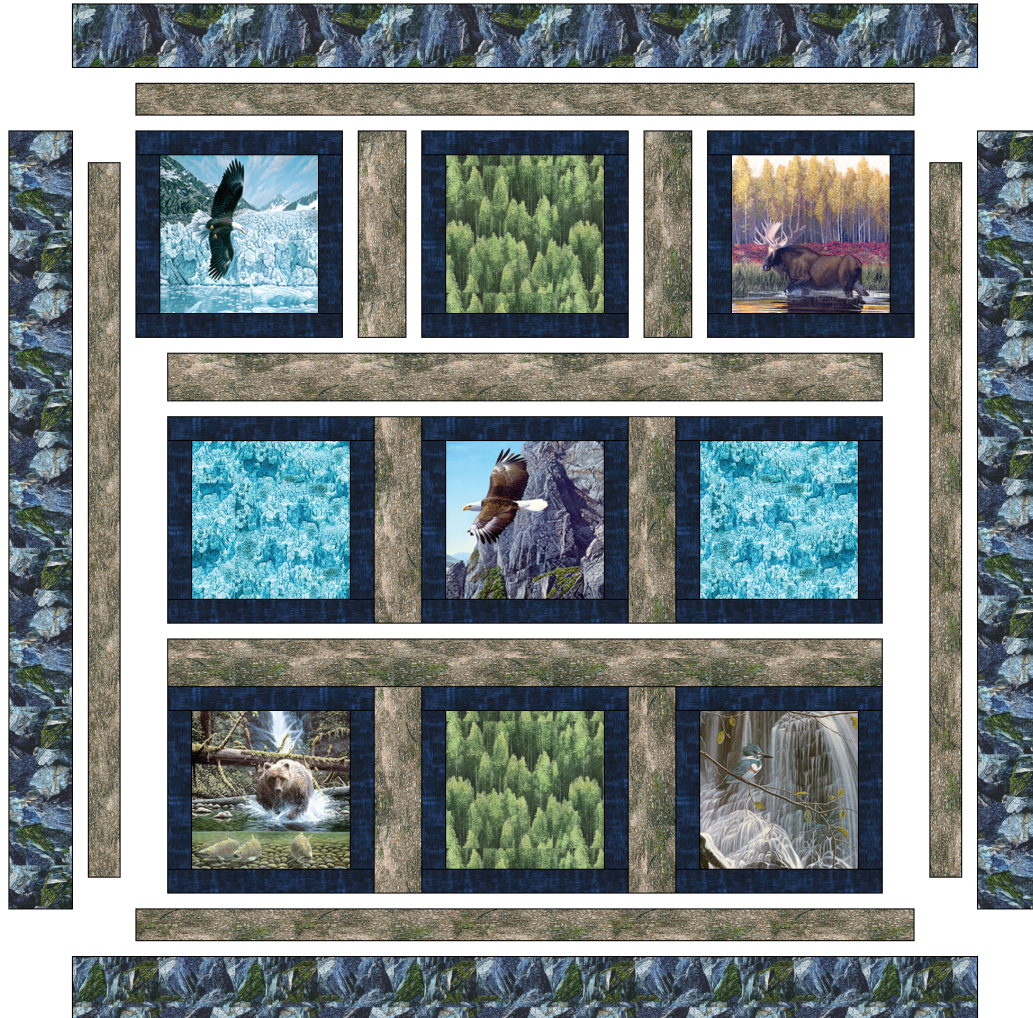
Step 4: Repeat Steps 1-2 using a 10-1/2" Fabric B square in place of the Fabric A square to make two Fabric B blocks.



Step 5: Repeat Steps 1-2 using a 10-1/2" Fabric C square in place of the Fabric A square to make two Fabric C blocks.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 6: Arrange the blocks into three rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Separate the blocks in each row with a 3-1/2" x 13-1/2" Fabric E vertical sashing strip.

Step 7: Sew the blocks and vertical sashing strips together to form rows. Press the seams toward the sashing strips.

Step 8: Separate the rows with the 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" Fabric E horizontal sashing strips. Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press toward the sashing strips.

Step 9: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
