## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From each of Fabrics A, D, F, G, I, J, N, P, Q, R, U, V, and W, cut:
one $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of each fabric. Subcut:
four 5-1/2" squares of each fabric.
From each of Fabrics B, E, H, K, L, M, O, S, and T, cut:
one $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of each fabric. Subcut:
four $5-1 / 2$ " squares.
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips of each fabric.
Sew the two strips of the same fabric together end-to-end, then subcut:
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip of each fabric.
From Fabric C, cut:
one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 5-1/2" squares.
six $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 2" $\times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner top/bottom borders.
two 2 " $\times 63-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner side borders.

## From Fabric X , cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 5-1/2" squares.
seven $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 4-1/2" $\times 69-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer top/bottom borders.
two 4-1/2" $\times 63-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer side borders.
From Fabric $Y$, cut:
twenty-eight $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
three-hundred and eighty-four 3 " squares.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3" Fabric Y square.
Step 2: Place a marked square on two opposite corners of $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Sew on the marked lines, then trim the excess fabric $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seams. Press.


Step 3: Place a marked square on each of the two remaining corners of the unit. Sew on the marked lines, then trim the excess fabric 1/4" way from the sewn seams. Press.


Step 4: Repeat to make four units using 5-1/2" Fabric A squares.

Step 5: Arrange the four units in two rows of two. Sew the units together to form rows, then press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.

Step 6: Repeat to make a total of twenty-four blocks using Fabrics B-X.


## Assemble the Quilt

Step 7: Arrange the blocks into four columns of six blocks. Place the 2-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2$ " sashing strips in between the columns. Note the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form columns. Press the seams towards the bottom.

Step 9: Sew the groups of three sashing strips together to form a column. Press.

Step 10: Sew the columns together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams
 open or towards the sashing strips.

Step 11: Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
